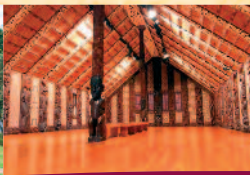


Nau Mai, Haere Mai *Welcome to our Birthplace*

Set in park-like grounds overlooking the Bay of Islands, the Waitangi Treaty Grounds is New Zealand's most historic site where, in 1840, the Treaty of Waitangi was signed between Maori Chiefs and the British Crown.

Join us on a guided tour and walk in the footsteps of our ancestors. Experience Maori cultural performances and the excitement of the haka. Be amazed by *Ngatokimatawhaorua*, the world's largest ceremonial waka (canoe). Step inside the Treaty House and learn about the treasures within. Visit Te Whare Runanga, the unique carved Maori meeting house.
