Vision of Trust

The Trustees shall hold the Trust Fund upon trust to pay or apply in New Zealand the income and the capital of the Trust Fund in such amounts, at such times, and subject to such terms and conditions, as the Trustees may decide for all or any of the following charitable purposes.

1. To create, develop, maintain and promote opportunities for the economic well-being in the Paihia Community and its surrounds;
2. To promote the social and cultural development of the Paihia community; and
3. To enhance, develop and maintain Paihia's physical environment while at the same time providing local employment opportunities.

Work to be undertaken 2010/11

The General Manager is responsible for the following activities in the first year:

- Setting up of the day-to-day operations of the Trust
- Development of a three year strategic plan and associated business planning requirements for (new) Trustee approval and adoption
- Securing funding to sustainably operate and other associated projects
- Temporary upgrade of the CBD waterfront roading system
- Upgrade of the Paihia/Opuia track
- 'Future' community design (village theme clarified)
- Develop Bay of Islands marketing initiative in conjunction with Enterprise Northland, Destination Northland and any other similar organisations

Work to be undertaken 2010/11

- Develop a strong working relationship with local government
- Management of the targeted rates fund
- Investigation and securing of appropriate community contracts
- Working with Business Paihia and others to look at up-skilling of staff, including seasonal staff
- Reviewing of safety and security measures for the community
- Developing and continuing enhancing an events calendar (new and current)
- Regular community communications
- Other duties as may be directed and agreed by the Trustees
